Prohibition of cutting turf in the shoreline of lakes and watercourses

Dear citizens,

The purpose of this notice is to remind you that under Article 4.1 of the Vallée-de-la Gatineau MRC interim control by-law 2018-325. It is forbidden to cut grass along watercourses along a shoreline at least 10 meters (32'9.7 "). When the slope is greater than 30% this band extends to 15 meters. A band of two meters is allowed around the buildings erected in the riparian strip donations implantation is protected by acquired rights.

This measure is essential for the protection of lakes and rivers. It aims to slow down runoff and avoid bank erosion.

We are counting on your cooperation to comply with this bylaw, otherwise the municipality of Low could be forced to issue reports of infractions to the offending citizens.

We are counting on your good cooperation and thank you for respecting the law.
