

Return of proximity health services

**MR. ROBERT BUSSIÈRE, MNA FOR GATINEAU IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE RETURN OF PROXIMITY HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE POPULATION OF THE GATINEAU RIDING.**

**Chelsea, April 1st 2019.** — The announcement was made this afternoon during in a press conference held by Mrs. Danielle McCann, Minister of Health and Social Services, in company of Mr. Mathieu Lacombe, Minister for the Family and Minister responsible of the Outaouais region.

Our Government is announcing the addition of two nursing positions, one at the CLSC in Low and the other at the CLSC in Chelsea, both in the Gatineau riding. Furthermore, both CLSC's will benefit from the addition of an Administrative Assistant.

Our Government is engaged in returning proximity health care services to the population. It is very important for all citizens in the Gatineau riding to have available quality proximity health services.

These measures are available due to an investement of 10 million dollars in the first provincial budget of our Government in regards to the re-deployment of services dispensed by the CLSC.
