GENERAL MAINTENANCE WORKER

Job Description:

The General Maintenance Worker is responsible for the upkeep of municipal infrastructure, including buildings, parks, and public spaces. He (she) works under the supervision of the Municipal Inspector and/or the Director General.

Responsibilities:

- Care and Maintenance
- Perform general maintenance and repair of municipal infrastructure and equipment
- Perform maintenance of the recycling and materials sorting centre, the pumping station and the public docks
- Cut, prune and plant trees
- Water and plant flowers and shrubs
- Clean sidewalks and driveways
- Spread salt or sand on sidewalks and driveways
- Mow and maintain grass
- Clean washrooms and municipal facilities

Other Tasks

- Operate various municipal vehicles (grader, excavator, tandem etc.)
- Assist during special events
- Prepare the room for Municipal Council meetings and others
- Perform all other duties necessary for the actualization of the mission and mandates of the municipality.
