WHEREAS the vast territory of the MRC de la Vallée-de-la-Gatineau (MRCVG), which means considerable travel for municipalities to access the only compressor available on the territory, for the territory's fire safety services (SSI);

WHEREAS because of this distance, SSIs have to travel to other regions to meet their needs, so the need to provide access to this equipment in two locations on the territory becomes essential;

WHEREAS municipalities cannot acquire such equipment on their own and that a request has been made to the MRC to proceed with the purchase of two compressors, an expense not provided for in the MRC's 2024 budget;

WHEREAS the expense, not provided for in the MRCVG budget, will be allocated in accordance with by-law 2023 383 currently in force at the MRCVG;

WHEREAS following its acquisition, the MRC will install a compressor in the facilities of the SSI of the Municipality of Grand-Remous and the SSI of the Municipality of Kazabazua, and that intermunicipal agreements will be signed with all municipalities concerned to define the roles and responsibilities of each party and the related financial costs;

WHEREAS the Mayors' Council's recommendation when presenting the project in the preamble to the June 18, 2024 Mayors' Council.
