

The general tax rate increased from \$0.59434/\$100 of assessment to \$0.6626/\$100 of assessment. The average tax for the removal of residual materials has decreased from \$520 in 2024 to \$410 in 2025, due to the reimbursement of costs related to recyclable materials by Éco-Entreprise Québec as of January 1, 2025.

ACCOUNT PAYMENT

Payment of the tax bill is due on March 31, 2025. However, a tax bill that exceeds \$300 may be paid in 4 installments:

- 1. On or before March 31
- 2. By May 30
- 3. By July 29
- 4. By September 29

Method of payment of municipal taxes

- 1. Through your financial institution
- 2. By mail: cheque or postal order
- 3. Cash and Interac in person.

Credit cards are not accepted.

Unpaid balances shall bear interest at the rate of fifteen percent (15%) per annum from the time they become due.

The total amount for the year becomes payable as soon as the payment of one (1) coupon has not been made by the deadline indicated above.

A penalty of 0.5% of the unpaid principal per full month of delay, to a maximum of 5% per annum, shall be added to the amount of taxes due.

PROPERTY ASSESSMENT FOR 2023-2024-2025

The property assessment roll is a summary of the inventory of immovables located on the territory of a municipality, evaluated on the same basis and on the same date. In effect for three fiscal years, it is used primarily to indicate the value of immovables to establish municipal property taxation.

The value of properties for this roll is based on the market value as of July 1, 2021, in accordance with section 46 of the Act respecting municipal taxation. The Gatineau Valley MRC is designated as the organization responsible for the assessment roll.

WASTE COLLECTION

Since January 1, 2025, there has been a new selective collection system designed to promote recyclable materials. We encourage you to adopt this new habit of sorting residual materials and depositing them in the appropriate bins.

MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN 2025

On November 2, Low voters will be invited to the polls to elect a new municipal council. At its regular meeting of October 7, 2024, the Municipality adopted a resolution bearing number 2024-151, to offer non-domiciled voters such as owners or co-owners of a building or occupants of a business establishment the opportunity to vote by mail.
